*Excerption from category 3rd, article 7th of "NCNU Right and Interest Protection Guideline on Subsidy Students", the copyright attribution of Subsidy student's learning activity related research outcomes, except from the covenants set out in any agreement for both, should follow the following principles:

I. Attribution of copyright:

- If the faculty instruction is only providing concept guidance instead of participation in the writing
 process of research paper, Master or PhD Dissertation, the student who independently complete his/her
 paper or dissertation should be the full author. The author of a work shall enjoy copyright upon
 completion of the work (including Moral rights and Economic Rights) in accordance with ROC
 Copyright Act.
- 2. If the faculty instruction is not only providing concept guidance but also participation in the writing process of research paper, Master or PhD Dissertation; under circumstances that a joint work is a work that has been completed by student and faculty where the creation of each person cannot be separately exploited therefore the student and faculty are co-authors and are joint right holders. Joint rights (including Moral rights and Economic Rights) in a work shall not be exercised except with the consent of the entire joint rights holders.
- II. **Attribution of patent right**: According to ROC Patent Right Act, 2nd item, Article 5. Subject to the provisions otherwise provided for in this Act or the covenants otherwise set out in any agreement, the term of "the owner of the right to apply for patent" shall mean any student inventor, student utility model creator or student designer. If others (e.g. instructors) have substantial contribution to the research outcomes, the referred others may be listed as joint inventors, joint utility model creators, and joint designers.
